Preliminary Remarks

Comité International Pierre de Coubertin (CIPC)

The *Comité International Pierre de Coubertin* (CIPC) was founded in Lausanne on 19 January 1975. The principal initiators who constituted a non-profit committee were Paul Martin (1901–1987), Jacques Guhl (1922–2024) and Raymond Pittet, who had the privilege of knowing Pierre de Coubertin personally.

Paul Martin, a Swiss physician, distinguished himself not only in the medical field but also as an athlete. He represented Switzerland in the 800-metre event at five editions of the Olympic Games: Antwerp (1920), Paris (1924), Amsterdam (1928), Los Angeles (1932), and Berlin (1936). Jacques Guhl was a dedicated educator and prolific writer, known particularly for founding a football school in Sion. (In cooperation with the French Pierre de Coubertin Committee) The two Swiss founders endeavoured to enhance the international visibility of Pierre de Coubertin (1863–1937)—not solely as the founder of the modern Olympic Movement but equally as an educator, cultural theorist, and reformer of education. Their objective was to promote a systematic study, preservation, and dissemination of Coubertin’s intellectual, pedagogical, and philosophical legacy on a global scale.

In 1984, the CIPC received official recognition from the International Olympic Committee (IOC) as an IOC-recognized organization. By virtue of this status, and under specific conditions, the Committee is authorized to employ the Olympic rings within its emblem and in the context of its project activities (www.coubertin.org).

At present, the CIPC comprises 132 individual members, 36 National Pierre de Coubertin Committees (NPCCs), and 36 Pierre de Coubertin Schools. The NPCCs in Africa and Latin America have established continental associations: the *Centro Latinoamericano de Estudios Coubertinianos* and the *Association of National Pierre de Coubertin Committees of Africa*, respectively. Through this structure of personal and institutional membership, the CIPC manifests a distinct continental differentiation which contributes significantly to its international presence and academic outreach.

This organizational framework facilitates the effective pursuit and dissemination of the Committee’s principal objectives, which may be summarized as follows:

1. **Biographical documentation of Pierre de Coubertin** and comprehensive portrayal of his multifaceted profile as historian, educational reformer, scientific journalist, founder of the Olympic Movement, and President of the International Olympic Committee from 1896 to 1925.
2. **In-depth analysis of Coubertin’s guiding concepts of Olympism** and their enduring relevance for the contemporary Olympic Movement.
3. **Promotion and practical application of the values of Olympism** within the context of physical education in schools and sports clubs at both national and international levels.

The first two objectives are pursued within a scholarly and research-oriented framework through academic publications, lectures, symposia, and conferences. These activities serve to examine and contextualize Coubertin’s work within educational discourse, the genesis of the Olympic Games, and the historical, social, peace-educational, and philosophical dimensions of Olympism.

The third objective finds its principal expression in the *International Pierre de Coubertin Youth Forums*, inaugurated in Le Havre in 1997 and subsequently convened at approximately biennial intervals, each time hosted by a different country. The forums are directed towards students aged 14 to 17, who are

accompanied and mentored by teachers from the network of Pierre de Coubertin Schools. The NPCCs of the respective host nations—including France, Great Britain, Switzerland, Italy, Austria, the Czech Republic, Greece, China, Norway, Slovakia, Estonia, and Germany—have supported the CIPC in the planning and implementation of these five- to seven-day events.

During the Youth Forums, workshops, practical sports sessions, and competitions are organized to embody and convey the core values of Olympism—**Excellence, Friendship, and Respect**—both through sporting experience and in their translation to daily life. Since the first forum in 1997, more than 1,200 students representing approximately 25 Pierre de Coubertin Schools from nearly all continents have participated in these gatherings, thereby contributing to the international diffusion of Coubertin’s educational ideals and the living spirit of Olympism.

With its combination of a scholarly orientation and practice-oriented projects on Olympism, the *Comité International Pierre de Coubertin* (CIPC) demonstrates an exemplary approach to not only situating Pierre de Coubertin’s work within its historical context but also to interpreting and applying it meaningfully in the present. For this very reason, the CIPC is held in high regard by the International Olympic Committee (IOC).

About the Archive Research Guide

Since 2019, the CIPC Archive has been housed at the Olympic Studies Centre of the German Sport University Cologne. In addition to documents and materials produced by the governing bodies of the CIPC, the archive also preserves records and artefacts related to CIPC activities and events, such as the International Pierre de Coubertin Youth Forums.

The archive is accessible for future projects in the fields of sport, culture, history, and education. The CIPC welcomes public enquiries and research requests concerning its holdings. Beyond the official CIPC Archive, a number of documents related to Pierre de Coubertin’s life and work can also be found within the holdings of the Carl and Lieselott Diem Archive at the German Sport University Cologne. These historical materials have likewise been integrated into the CIPC Archive for the purposes of preservation and research accessibility.

The **Archive Research Guide** has been compiled to provide both national and international researchers, sports administrators, journalists, students, educators, and teachers with structured access to the holdings of the CIPC Archive. It lists various categories of materials, including documents originating directly from the CIPC, personal collections of individuals involved in the Committee’s work, and archival materials gathered independently by the Olympic Studies Centre Cologne at the German Sport University Cologne.

Given the diverse origins of the materials, it is not always possible to identify the precise provenance of every item within the collection. Box numbers correspond to the physical storage locations within the archive and therefore do not follow a chronological sequence. Within each box, folders are listed with their respective size, date range, and content description. The materials contained within individual folders are not further itemized or numbered. Wherever feasible, the original titles of file folders and transferred materials have been retained to preserve archival authenticity.

We have now published Volume I of the Archive Research Guide, and additional volumes will follow to complete the archive of the IPCC. Some archival materials are still stored in decentralized locations.

Former Presidents and Director Generals of the IPCC, as well as organizers of the International Coubertin Youth Forums, have already expressed their intention to transfer these materials to staff members of the Olympic Studies Centre at the German Sport University Cologne. A substantial

collection of large volumes of reports, minutes, programmes, articles, and other documents is expected to be gathered, archived, catalogued and digitized. The evaluation and preparation of these materials will support academic, didactic, and educational work, contributing to a contemporary understanding of Pierre de Coubertin's diverse activities.
